**“And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.”**

- **Matthew 24:14**

The scripture cited above from Matthew 24:14, are the Words of Jesus – a direct quote. What did Jesus state? The Gospel of the Kingdom should be preached as a witness to the entire world and then the end shall come. It is a very simple instruction – an instruction that any committed Christian preacher should understand. Jesus understood it and that is why during his earthly ministry he only preached two things: 1. Repentance; 2. The Kingdom of God. Jesus after preaching, confirmed the Gospel of the Kingdom with miraculous signs following. The Apostles understood the instructions and after Jesus' resurrection, his 40 days spent with the Apostles (teaching on things pertaining to the Kingdom of God as it states in Acts 1:2) and His ascension into Heaven, they preached the Gospel of the Kingdom and confirmed the Word with signs following. Finally, the Early Church (before the advent of the Roman Catholic Church who hi-jacked the Church and took it down an errant theological road) preached the Gospel of the Kingdom and confirmed the Word with signs following – the end result was the Early Church turning the world 'upside down' for the Kingdom of God. It was a simple instruction given by Jesus through the Holy Spirit...and yet why does the Church today not follow the Kingdom roadmap that will lead to Jesus returning to the Earth?

Today's Church teaches on many things, but the majority of the subjects deal with "self-gratification": *How you can have more money, how you can get healed, how you can be successful in life, how to have a better marriage, how to walk in happiness, how to walk in the Blessing, etc., etc., etc.* The Body of Christ heaps unto itself teachers who become very popular and wealthy by filling Believers' ears with words that feed their desires. Even evangelists preach salvation messages not based upon the full purpose of salvation through Jesus Christ – which is, Jesus is the ONLY way into the Kingdom of God – but as a threat message that tells the hearer a partial scary truth: If they don't receive Jesus as Lord they will go to hell...Yes, there are many different messages in today's Church World but they are not the Gospel of the Kingdom.

We all believe that Jesus is coming back soon. But what is the purpose for His returning? To give you a bag full of money so you will be prosperous, or to heal your body, or bring you success, or to make your life easier? No, Jesus is coming back to the Earth to establish His Kingdom – The Kingdom of God. What is our job before that happens? We are to prepare the way for the Lord's return: We are Kingdom Messengers, we are Christ's Ambassadors, and as such we are to preach the Gospel of the Kingdom AND Demonstrate the Gospel of the Kingdom with Signs, Wonders and Miracles – being a Witness for the Kingdom of God and heralding the soon coming King Jesus. When will Jesus return? He states it clearly: When the Gospel of the Kingdom is preached in all the world for a witness...then shall the end come: And not before! **Learn to follow instructions and become a true Disciple of Jesus – heed His instructions and preach the Gospel of the Kingdom to all the world as a Kingdom Witness and prepare Jesus' return!**
